COVID-19 Parent Information

COVID-19 is a new disease, caused by a novel (or new) coronavirus that has not previously been seen in humans. The virus that causes COVID-19 is thought to spread mainly from person to person, mainly through respiratory droplets produced by an infected person. These droplets can land in the mouths or noses of people who are nearby or possibly be inhaled into the lungs. Spread is more likely when people are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet).

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from none to mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus.

Waverly-Shell Rock Community Schools will be adhering to the guidance from the Iowa Department of Public Health when evaluating ill students in the health office. The guidance from the Iowa Department of Public Health is as follows:

Students who have <u>ANY high-risk symptom</u> OR <u>two or more low risk symptoms</u> should not be in school and are advised to seek an evaluation by a healthcare provider.

STUDENTS MAY RETURN TO SCHOOL WHEN:

Situation 1: If child is NOT evaluated by a healthcare provider:

- At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared AND
- No fever for at least 24 hours (that is ONE full day without the use of medicine that reduces fevers)
- Symptoms have improved

Situation 2: If a child is evaluated by a healthcare provider and determines one of the following:

- Negative COVID-19 test and NO known exposurewith no fever (without the use of fever reducing medicine) AND symptoms improving. (Physician's note is required).
- Alternative diagnosis- Students may return to school after 24 hours with no fever (without the use of fever-reducing medicine) AND symptoms improving (Physician's note required).
- **Positive COVID-19 test-** Return to school 10 days after symptoms started, **AND** 24 hours with no fever (1 full day without fever-reducing medications) **AND** symptoms have improved.
